Having spent many years training teachers and performers in her positions as Professor and Head of Musicianship at the RIAM and Head of Educational Music at the Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama, she now pursues a career as a freelance teacher and conductor in Ireland and the UK. She is currently Musical Director of SRP (Ireland) and SRP (Glasgow) and a member of the teaching faculty of the Irish Recorder and Viol Course at Termonfechin, Co. Louth.
