## **DIRECTIONS TO INVERLEITH ST. SERF'S HALL**

Buses from Edinburgh City Centre take around 15 minutes to reach Inverleith St. Serf's. Bus stops are a short walk from either Waverley Station, or the Bus Station. You will be going in a northerly direction from the city centre. There is a choice of several buses. Below I have listed the 3 most convenient bus services.

**Service 23 going in the direction of Trinity** is the most convenient bus which you can take either from The Mound or from Hanover Street (off Princes Street). This will stop in Clark Road beside the venue.

**Service 27 going in the direction of Silverknowes** also from The Mound or Hanover Street will take you to Goldenacre which is approximately 5 minutes walk from the venue.

**Service 8 going in the direction of Muirhouse** from the North Bridge or St James Centre or Broughton Street will also take you to Goldenacre.
