The Society continued to promote the recorder as a serious instrument, to facilitate the raising of standards, and provide opportunities for playing to all who join, mainly through group playing in branch meetings and larger Festivals.

The final of the international **1999 Moeck/SRP Solo Recorder Playing Competition**, for players aged up to 30 years, was held on 31 October 1999 during the Early Music Exhibition at the Royal College of Music, London. The winner, Pia Loman (Sweden) presented the Winner's Recital on 25 February 2000 in the Wigmore Hall, London.

The Walter Bergmann Fund, administered by a Sub-Committee, continued to give grants to further the studies of young players in financial need. Many members contributed to the fund-raising in various ways.

The CSRP (certificate for conductors and directors), was administered by the Examinations Sub-Committee. Several candidates are known to be preparing for it.

Branches undertook activities in the wider community. Examples included: playing in public places like shopping centres, with charitable collections; workshops in primary schools; performances in residential and nursing homes and hospices and at church services; public performances that increase public perceptions that the recorder is a serious and enjoyable instrument.

The **SRP National Recorder Festival** was held on 29 and 30 April 2000 in Felixstowe, Suffolk.

The **SRP Scottish Recorder Festival** was held on 17 June 2000 in Alva, Clackmannanshire.

The membership supplied **The Recorder Magazine** (published by Peacock Press) quarterly to members. The Society has editorship of four pages in each issue to communicate with members and publicise itself. The Society's Internet site http://www.srp.org.uk/ continued to be developed as a public information resource.
