

## LOCATION OF ANTIOCH HOUSE, CROSSGATE, DURHAM CITY



Antioch House is easy to reach from the Railway Station or the Bus Station (both marked on the map). By road, it is most convenient to use the Park and Ride car-parks signposted from the A.690 from the direction of Sunderland and the A1(M) and from the A.167 from both north and south approaches to the city.

### **Disabled access**

The playing-day will take place on the ground floor so there are no stairs to climb. There is, however, no special disabled access available, and there is quite a steep slope from the town to the front door of Antioch House, although it is possible to come by taxi.



**Annemarie Klein's** main instrument is the recorder, but she is also proficient as a basso continuo player, has recently taken up the baroque oboe and has sung in various choral chamber groups. She teaches courses at Higham Hall, Recorder Summer School, Easter Recorder Course, Summer Recorder Festival, and Lyme Regis. Her academic research has mostly centred on music of the high baroque. She writes: 'As a professional musician, I hugely enjoy the variety a portfolio career offers. I divide my time between performing, teaching and translating texts about music. The beauty of this work is that each of those elements enhances the other. Being an accomplished player on the recorder can be encouraging, and helps to show people what can be done on the instrument. Variety is one of the key ingredients in a great programme for a playing day. My great love is early music, but I enjoy both performing and conducting music from the mediaeval to the modern. My musical training has given me the ability to analyse, arrange and interpret pieces from all eras. The same counts for the level: I believe in a mixture, from pieces that people are very comfortable with, to those that are a bit of a challenge, as it adds to the enjoyment and allows one to work on many different aspects of playing.'
