DIRECTIONS TO TOPP WAY

We recommend parking at Topp Way car park via Topp Way.

From M6 north / north west

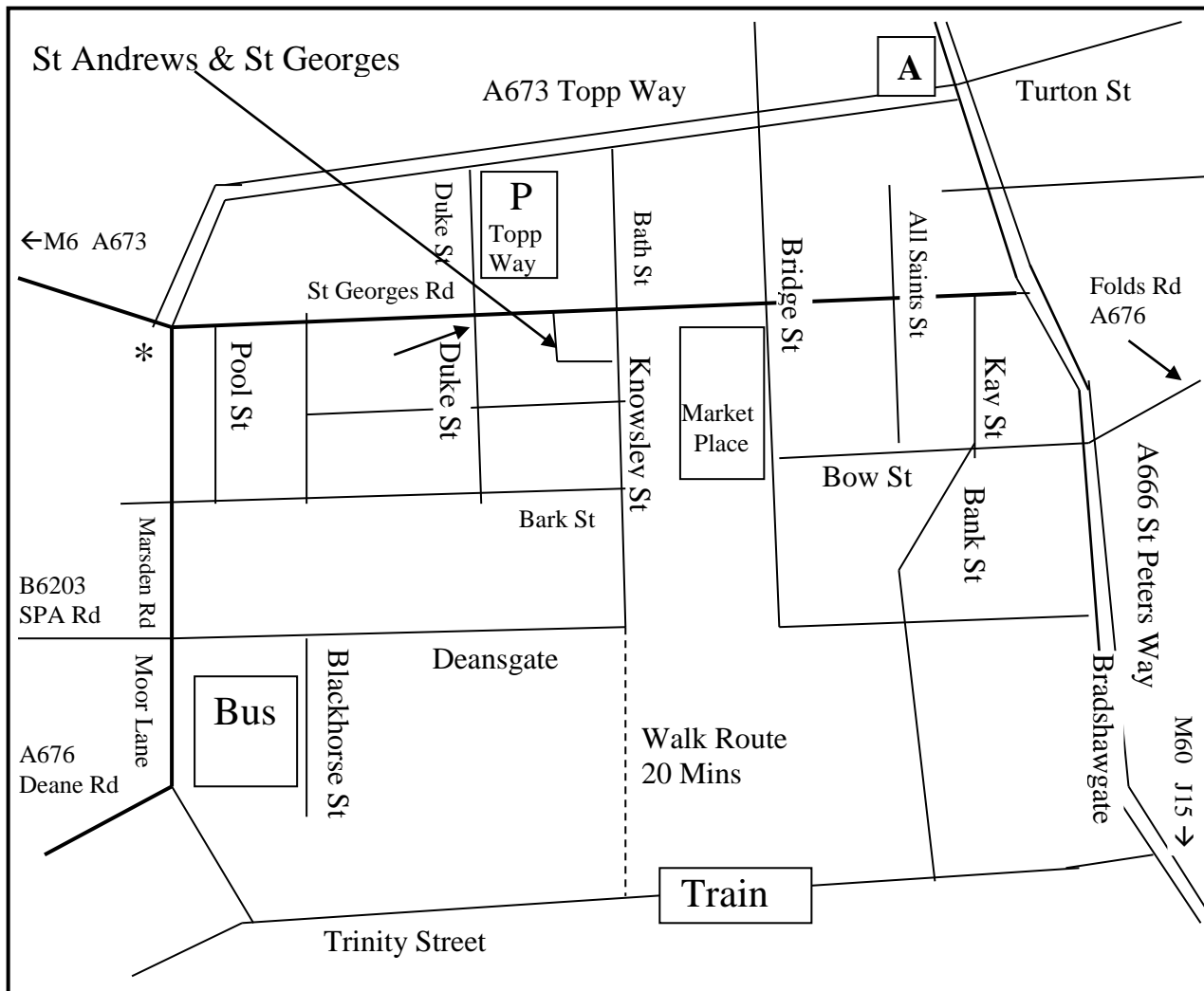
Take M61 & exit at J6, turning left on to the A6027. After about a mile, at the 2nd roundabout turn right on to the A673 – Chorley New Road – in the direction of Bolton. After about 3 miles you reach the edge of the town centre and the large junction of Topp Way & St George's Rd. From here many roads are one way so please look on google maps or satnav.

From Burnley

Approaching from Ramsbottom, follow directions to Bolton Centre. Go along A676 & at dual carriageway there are traffic lights (directions to M60/ M61) Take right lane into Turton Street A673 & get into middle lane. This leads into Topp Way (A).

South from M62 & M60

From J15 on M60 keep right and follow the directions and lanes to Bolton on the A666. Disregard all turnoffs until you come to the first set of traffic lights on the Main Road. Turn left onto Topp Way (A on Map).

PARKING:

We recommend using the Topp Way multi-storey car park (BL1 2DJ) accessed from Duke St, just off Topp Way (A). More information is available on Bolton Council's web site. The Topp Way car park is free on Saturdays.

The Council also runs a free town centre bus. The Metroshuttle runs every 15 minutes from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm on Saturdays. It passes both bus station and train station and goes along St. Georges Road. The bus stop is on the corner of Knowsley Street, just opposite the church.
