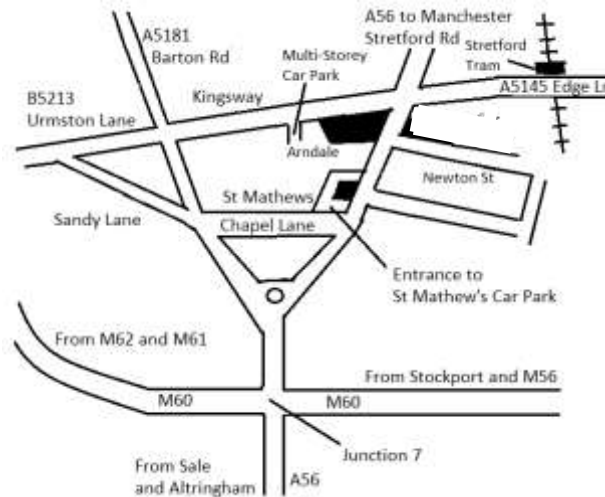


Directions

St Matthew's Church Hall, Chapel Lane, Stretford M32 9AJ

NB: Parking on Chapel Lane causes problems for residents.



There are frequent **buses** Nos. 263, 255, 256 and 15 from Piccadilly Gardens which is about ¼ mile from Piccadilly Railway Station. 23 minutes journey.

There are also **trams** (heading towards Altrincham) from the City Centre, Piccadilly and Victoria Bus Station. Passengers alight at Stretford. If you arrive by train, we recommend that you use the tram all the way. Bus and tram information available at www.tfgm.com or 0161 228 7811.

From M60 Motorway Junction 7

Keep left at roundabout into Barton Rd.
First right into Chapel Lane. Entrance on left at end.

From the City Centre

Travel south down A56 Chester Road.
Continue past the Stretford Mall Shopping Centre and the tall block of flats at the roundabout.
NB: You cannot turn right into Chapel Lane.
Make sure that you are in the outside lane before the roundabout, and turn right into Barton Road.
First right into Chapel Lane. Entrance to car park on left at end.
