She also performs regularly with period instrument orchestras, a trio sonata ensemble and a folk duo.

The day will include a variety of music from renaissance to modern, and we hope to have enough large instruments to include multi choir settings and pieces for recorder orchestra

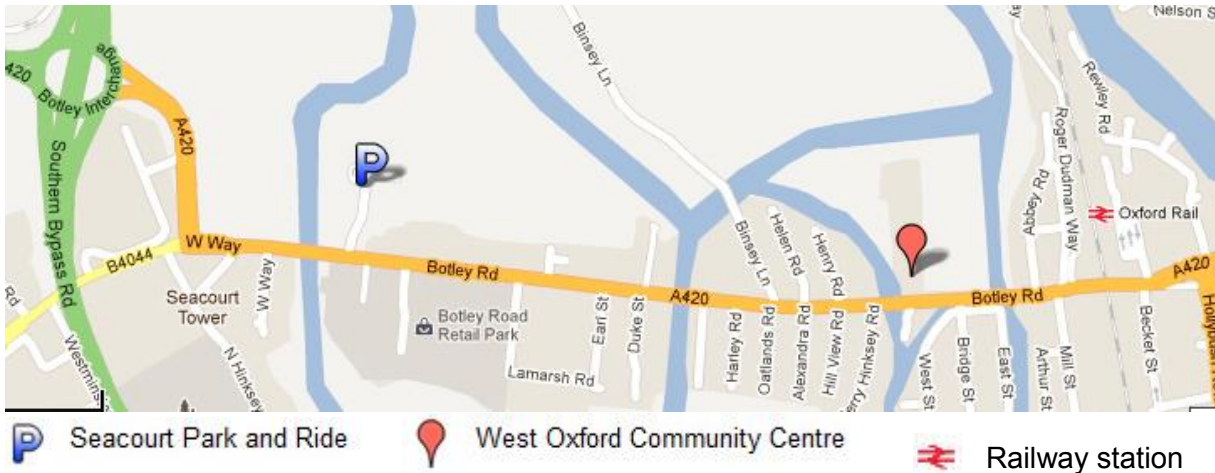

## Getting to West Oxford Community Centre

The Centre is on the West side of Oxford, on the Botley Road opposite St Frideswide's Church.



### Buses

Because of the closure of Botley Road at Oxford railway station, bus services are not operating normally. ### Car

Because of the closure of Botley Road at Oxford railway station, you need to approach the centre from the West rather than driving through central Oxford. There are “Road Closed” signs before you get to the centre but you can go through them if you are going to the centre. Although work at the A34 Botley interchange has caused problems early in the year, this should be finished by April, and if not there are ways to avoid it. For further information and the latest updates, please go to our website at <https://srp.org.uk/oxford> and click the **Venue** button. The centre itself does have a small car park. In addition up to two parking spaces are available at the church opposite. There is almost no street parking (except for cars with West Oxford Residents parking permits or Visitor permits). Alternatively, there is the Seacourt Park and Ride [http://www.parkandride.net/oxford/html/oxford\\_parkandride.html](http://www.parkandride.net/oxford/html/oxford_parkandride.html) close by. From the park and ride it's a short walk, or take a bus towards the City Centre and get off at the first stop.

### Train

The centre is 10 minutes' walk from the station. Follow the main Botley Road west out of town. Cross the river and we are right opposite the church.

### Accessibility
