## **How to get to Henbury Village Hall**

Henbury is 2.5 miles north of Macclesfield on the A537 (Knutsford) road.

From the south, as the church comes in sight, take the road on the right leading away at a diagonal - this is Church Lane and the car park is a few yards up on the left.

From the north, you can turn left at The Blacksmith's Arms into Pepper Street, then right into Church Lane, where the church car park will then be on your right.

Henbury can be reached from Manchester, East Disbury and Wilmslow on the Arriva 130 bus route. There is a bus from Piccadilly Gardens at 08.58, arriving at Henbury around 10.20. In the other direction, buses leave Macclesfield bus station at 08 and 38 minutes past each hour (38 departures terminate at Wilmslow).
