Steve Marshall is from Gloucestershire and is a prolific composer and arranger of music for recorders. He has a background of jazz, blues and rock, publishes his own compositions under the banner of May Hill Edition, and conducts widely. He is particularly interested in the recorder orchestra, for which he writes extensively, and his compositions are performed by recorder orchestras throughout the world. Together with Pam Smith he set up the Phoenix Recorder Orchestra, the Chamber Recorder Orchestra of the West, and a regular series of Easy Recorder Orchestra days.

There will be four sessions of playing conducted by Steve, with breaks in between, including a break for lunch from 1.00p.m. to 2.00p.m. Refreshments at breaks are included, but please bring a packed lunch. There are also cafés and restaurants within walking distance. All music will be provided. **Please bring a music stand.**
