Isobel Clarke is a recorder player and music historian, who has recently completed her PhD at the Royal College of Music on the recorder's practical use and social and musical status in the seventeenth century. She is active as a performer and coach of both early and contemporary recorder repertoire, although her particular performance interest lies in the chamber music repertoire of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries. As well as teaching academic music studies at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, Isobel also tutors the recorder consort courses at the City Lit. Institute for Adult Education.
