

National Youth Recorder Orchestras GB Administrator's Report 2018-2019

During the year, 84 students booked onto our courses and recorder days, of whom 36 were new to NYRO. The equivalent figures for the previous year were 85 and 41. Recorder days were held in Birmingham, Edinburgh, Oxford, Cambridge, Bristol, London, Kent and Aberdeen.

Financial Position

The break-even budget for 2018-19 was based on finding £8,000 in grants and we fell short of our target by £2,500. This, coupled with a lower than expected attendance at the Summer Course, resulted in an overall deficit of £4,718.36 for the financial year.

Based on the budgeted figures, NYRO will need to raise at least £11,500 in grants and donations during the year 2019-20 in order to break even. This level of support and more will be required over a period of 2-3 years so as to rebuild reserves and avoid further cash flow problems in the future.

All monies owing at the year end have now been paid apart from the Administrator's Fees and Expenses, which are still outstanding. The total owing for these is £3,879.37.
