With the experience we have gained from organising our RfA zoom courses over the last few months we have decided to put together this 'virtual' Easter Recorder Course.

Although our courses, until now, have been solely for Recorders-for-All members we are opening this up to any recorder player who is missing the opportunity to play with others. Ok, so we can't play together in ensembles or orchestras but there are many things we CAN do on zoom. During these six days we will give you the opportunity to try many of the things which arguably work better online. Take risks - try out new fingerings or ornaments; go for those high notes; play all the parts, instead of just the tenor 2 line (!), and get to know the whole piece; play a sonata with keyboard; experience playing a 1:1 duet with a tutor...

Rather than losing yourself in a large group of players, improve your playing and your confidence from the privacy of your own home with no risk of feeling foolish or embarrassed.

At the end of the course join Jan and Pam for a (zoom) drink in the (zoom) bar and we can chat about whether it was all worth it. What worked. What didn't work. And there'll be a quiz.
