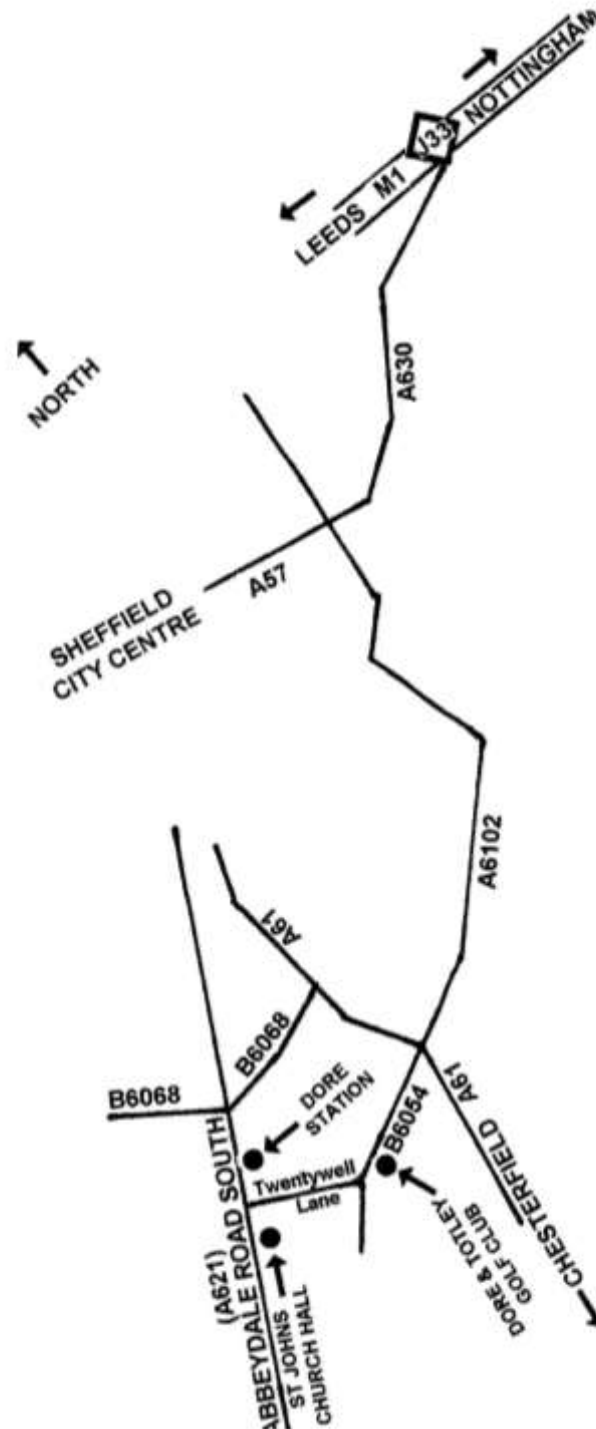

Recorder Maintenance

This presentation is for recorder players at all levels. It gives detail on what is meant by recorder 'voicing', demonstrates how sensitive the windway area is and how to identify changes in the sound that could be a result of windway changes.

The workshop includes a practical demonstration of the issues by making voicing adjustments to a recorder. Topics covered will include:

The recorder bore shape and its effect on tuning
Typical signs of voicing problems
Simple things to do to care for your recorder
Oiling recorders

Julie gained her BMus degree in 1998 at Goldsmith College. In 2006, after a successful management career in retail and the licensed trade, she returned to music attending Trinity Conservatoire of Music. She spent four years as a postgraduate studying the recorder with Rebecca Miles and Philip Thorby as well as Viola da Gamba with Alison Crum. Julie has had recorder tuition, courses and masterclasses with Piers Adams, Pamela Thorby,

Matthias Maute and Bart Spanhove.

She has performed widely, including at the Greenwich International Early Music Festival, St Martin-in-the -Fields, Handel House Museum, Southbank Centre and with numerous Ensembles.

Julie works actively with amateur recorder players, running several groups. She is one of the few teachers of the Suzuki method for the recorder. She is a regular tutor on the Easter Recorder Course.

Julie also runs the RecorderShop London.co.uk and has repaired and revoiced recorders for over 10 years. She has received training and guidance from Tim Cranmore and Tom Prescott.
