Described by The Times as a charismatic virtuoso, Tabea Debus is constantly exploring the horizons of music for recorder. As a soloist, Tabea has released seven solo albums and won prizes at the Festspiele Mecklenburg-Vorpommern and the SRP/Moeck International Solo Recorder Competition. She has collaborated with La Serenissima and The English Concert in concerts in UK, Europe and USA. In 2023, Tabea became a member of the recorder quartet Palisander, whose theatrical concerts are devised for audiences of all ages. An Associate of the Royal Academy of Music, since 2024 she has held the recorder professorship at the HMTM Hannover. Passionate about outreach work Tabea regularly leads masterclasses in music colleges of Europe and workshops with schoolchildren in UK.

Playing will start at **10am**, so plan to arrive in time to set up (doors open shortly after 9.30am). We aim to finish by **4pm**. There will be short breaks for coffee, lunch and tea. There is a pub in the village, but best to bring your own packed lunch. Free hot drinks and biscuits will be available.
