Miriam Monaghan (née Nerval) enjoys a portfolio career as a international recorder player, conductor, composer and teacher. She has an established career as a recorder player, having recorded for Disney, featured regularly on BBC Radio & Classic FM and frequently toured internationally with her recorder quartet, Palisander.

Since graduating from the Guildhall School of Music & Drama Miriam has also become a passionate educator, eager to share her love of the recorder & music with the next generation. In her role as Recorder & Music Makers Team Leader, she aims to ensure they can offer students the best start to their musical journeys. As a chamber musician she performs internationally with Palisander recorder quartet, giving concerts in over 15 countries, from Japan to Greece to the tiny Scottish Isle of Eigg! "Palisander – making recorders phenomenally interesting and exciting" – Katie Derham, BBC Radio 3'. In 2023, Miriam performed live and interviewed on BBC2 Newsnight discussing the recorder's vital role in UK music education. Miriam is a tutor and conductor for the National Youth Recorder Orchestra, as well as a conductor and Musical Advisor to the Society of Recorder Players.

HOW TO FIND US: Ruishton Village Hall TA3 5JD

From Junction 25 of M5: take the A358 towards Ilminster.

Turn left at the first traffic lights(after large pub).

Follow this road to the Y junction by the Ruishton Inn; keep left and continue for a few hundred yards until you reach the park on your left. The village hall is clearly visible just beyond the park.

From Ilminster: follow the A358 towards the M5. After the Thornfalcon traffic lights, the road narrows to single lane; past the traffic camera turn right into Lipe Lane. Follow that lane for 0.6ml then turn left into Cheats Road. The Village Hall is a short distance up on the right.

Parking is available next to the Hall
