Notes

1. The Constitution states that the purposes of the Society shall include "promotion of the education of the public in the study, practice and appreciation of the recorder and its repertoire". See the Constitution for a full statement.
2. The main reasons for disqualification include:
 - being convicted of an offence involving deception or dishonesty unless the conviction is time spent
 - being an undischarged bankrupt
 - having been removed from trusteeship of a charity by the court or the Charity Commission; and
 - being disqualified under an order under the Company Directors Act 1986.
3. It is an offence to act as a charity trustee whilst disqualified unless the Charity Commissioners have given a waiver under sections 178 and 179 of the Charities Act 2011
